

Postconference in the island of Capri we concluded that so much had already been researched, so many policies on start-ups and early-stage growth had been formulated, so many conferences and seminars held, and so much money was awash all around the globe. We talked about new combinations and even sustainability and values. But what was missing was being entrepreneurial in our thinking about crossing borders, disciplines and silos, and engaging in entrepreneurship as new forms of recombination with multiple perspectives facilitating productive change. Perhaps the beginning of this century offered hope in creating something different.


