People are left bereft of institutional values and governance safeguards. In this context while entrepreneurship is promoted widely, it is our contention that neither policy, nor research appear to have provided us with sufficient insights into the ways and means in which entrepreneurship and innovation can help to resolve the tensions and help secure sustainable outcomes for individuals, organisations, and societies.

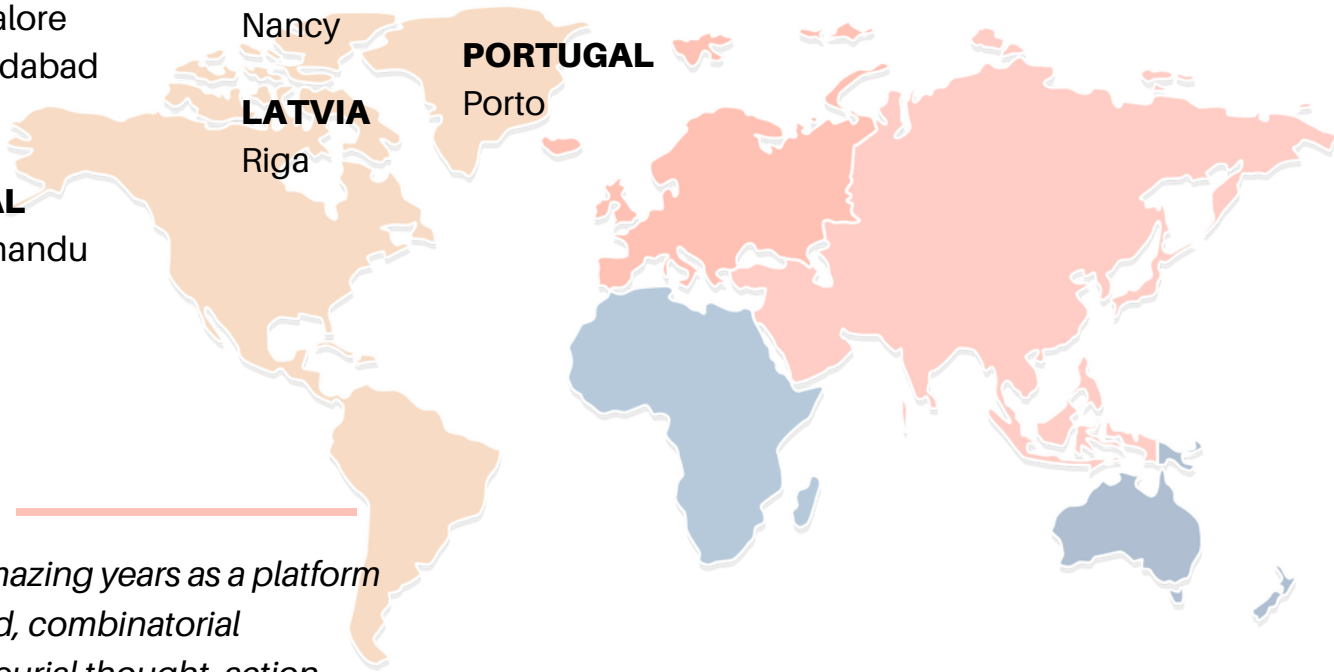

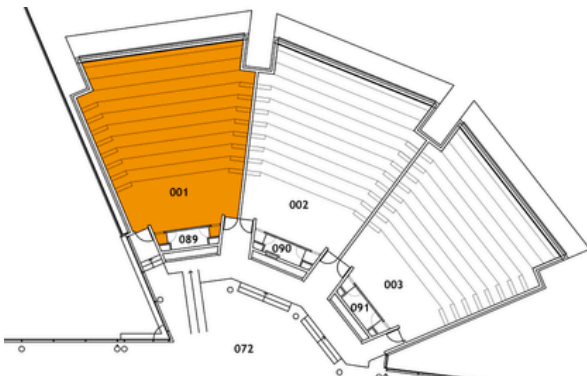

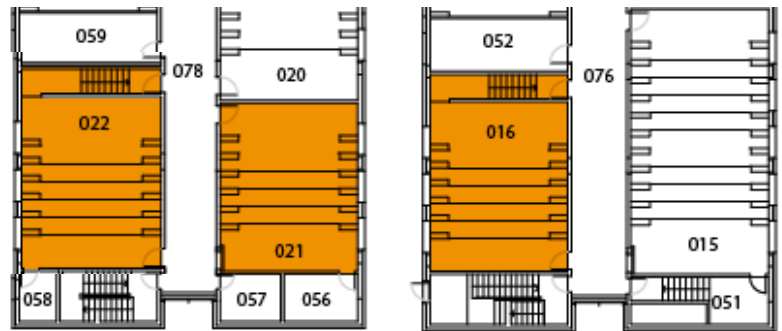


Conference Venue
